The Indianapolis Speedrome® is proud to welcome back EMAS as a part of the racing family. Their dedicated and talented staff will return as the sole provider of the Ambulatory services at the World's Home of the Figure 8®. The two-year deal will also contain a new outlet for EMAS and the Taylor family. They will now become the official racing parts supplier. A fully stocked parts trailer will be present at each and every racing event. These two services are ones that drivers wish not to experience, but are extremely pleased to have ready for their safety and to keep them on track.

"I am very excited about the upcoming season between the Speedrome and our company", exclaimed EMAS owner Sonny Taylor. "We are proud to support the track and its racing tradition beginning its 69th season. My family and my business have been a part of this place in some form or another now within a third generation". EMAS will furnish a full-time Ambulance for all the Speedrome activities. They also have plans to have a smaller unit to be in the spectator area for select bigger events.

Sonny Taylor began at the Speedrome in the early 1980's when he owned the three-car Late Model team of Dangerous Danny Turner, the Ironman Dean Griffin, and Sonny himself. He had a 1986 Speedrome feature win to his credit before trying his hand at some traveling series. Sonny stepped away from the driver's seat to help his son Tim, but was a constant sponsor of the Turner family. He made his home track return as a car owner in 2004 when he purchased a Late Model and promptly went out to win the North/South 100 Figure 8 with Danny at the wheel.

Sonny has eyes on the track championship in 2010. His team has several well-prepared machines in his stable with primary driver Corey Turner ready for action. The most successful Late Model rookie in the division's 31-year history piled up 4 feature victories including a pair on the Figure 8 on his way to an astounding runner-up in the 2005 point standings. Corey is a former Speedrome Stock champion and the most recent winner of California's biggest crossover contest. He has also captured the Snowball 100 and grabbed the coveted pole position for the 2005 World Figure 8® Championship.

Also hitting the track this year will be son Tim "the Tool Man" Taylor and for the first-time grandson Damron Taylor. Tim was an Indianapolis Speedrome regular during the mid-1990s. 1995 produced some of Tim's signature Speedrome Late Model feature wins including victories in the Triple 8, at the Anderson Speedway, and the first-ever division visit to the famed Putnam Park road course. He also was a top ten point's finisher in the National Figure 8 Challenge tour that season. He is also an ASA veteran and USA Modified series champion. He is very excited about his son testing the track for the first-time in 2010. He currently has only oval starts on his freshman schedule, but looks to try the Figure 8 in the near future.
