The Midwest Drift Union is ready for its first 2010 appearance at the Home of the World Figure 8®. This event is just another prime example of the variety of motorsports entertainment at the 69-year-old facility. The past few years have seen the afternoon drifting programs grow by leaps and bounds at the Indianapolis Speedrome®. And this season should be no different with doubleheader weekends being the new format. The first Saturday and Sunday afternoon affair is May 22 & 23. The NOS Midwest Drift Union 2010 Tour has already had two rounds of competition. They visited Ohio's Kil-Kare Speedway in mid-April and challenged across town at ORP just a few weeks ago. Clinton Florczyk came out on top at round one while Mike "T2" Feiock conquered the second round. On the strength of that win, Mike leads the overall point standings over Bill "Highlife" Cook, Cody Tope, Austin Barron, and Dustin Doherty. Each event's roster consists of many seasoned pros, novice newcomers, and every level in-between. You should come and check them out. Midwest Drift Union spectator admission is just \$10 with kid's 12 & under free.

These events at the Speedrome are a two-day practice and tandem show. It has a 32-driver capacity so teams get registered on their website today. Drifters must be 18-years-old to participate or if 16 or 17, they must have filled out the proper paperwork and have their parent or guardian present at the event. Each registration fee paid includes admittance for the driver and one crew member. The pre-registration price is \$75 with it rising to \$85 before May 22nd. Race day it is \$100 to enter. They also have a super saver special deal in which you can enter both days for a total of just \$125. See their web site for more details.

Each Midwest Drift Union event format at the Speedrome will have 2 run groups. A and B will each run several one hour sessions throughout the day. The organizers will also, to the best of their ability, be grouping drivers by experience level to make each session more efficient. This means a nice blend of advanced, intermediate, and beginning drivers to keep the groups consistent. Gates open at 6am with all cars going through tech shortly after. The on track activities will start at 8am and will run to 3pm. Again, join us for a full day of excitement. Midwest Drift Union spectator admission is just \$10 with kid's 12 & under free.
