What is the 2010 World Figure 8® Tour: It is a four-race Figure 8 series that leads up to the 34th Annual World Figure 8® Championship held at the Speedrome September 9th to 11th, 2010.

Who can race in the 2010 World Figure 8® Tour: It is open to all drivers that have competed previously in the World Figure 8® Championship as well as new drivers looking to debut in the event. All 2010 World Figure 8® Championship rules and 2010 Speedrome Rules of Competition apply. (See www.speedrome.com)

The 2010 World Figure 8® Tour Champion will receive \$1,000. They will also get a 5-foot championship trophy as well as a guaranteed locked-in (non-transferable) starting spot for the 34th Annual World Figure 8® Championship on September 11, 2010.

2010 World Figure 8® Tour \$500 BOUNCEBACK BONUS: If a driver can win a World Figure 8® Tour feature and comeback the very next night to win the Speedrome Late Model Figure 8 feature, they will receive a \$500 bonus on top of their earnings.

What tires will they run in the 2010 World Figure 8® Tour: The series will continue the World Figure 8® tradition of a common tire. These 10" tires will be available exclusively at the Speedrome.

2010 World Figure 8® Tour event format: Each night will have qualifications, heat races, and a 100-lap feature. Each main event will pay \$1,200 to the winner (see the full purse below). Drivers will receive qualifying, heat, and feature points towards the 2010 championship.
